MECA wants to provide its students with the highest quality of classical, contemporary, and multicultural performing and visual arts education. In order to do this, MECA students must observe program policies. For those students who are minors, parents must take responsibility for their children's artistic and academic growth by supporting these policies.

## Registration and Weekly fees

There is a **non-refundable** registration fee of \$30.00, \$45.00, or \$60.00 depending on when you register your child for the summer day camp. MECA's summer day camp cost is on a weekly fee basis, therefore, **it is due at the beginning of each week** (**Monday or Tuesday**), unless other arrangements have been made when consulting with the registrar. The fees may be paid by check, money order, credit card (Master/Visa). Credit card payments are preferred and can be made by phone or set up on a recurring basis by completing an authorization form. NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER CLASSES BEGIN. Any past due fees, for any MECA program, must be paid prior to enrolling in the summer day camp.

Fees are on a sliding scale depending on combined family income and the number of people in the household. **Proof of income is required.** Families must meet with the registrar for further assistance. Fees are not prorated if student misses a day of the week.

### MECA - 2024 Summer Sunburst Day Camp - COVID19 - Protocols

It is MECA's priority to provide a safe and healthy environment for all students. Due to the current COVID-19 (Coronavirus), we will be implementing additional guidelines that all students, parents, teaching staff and administrative must follow. At the end of this document all parents will be required to sign this document in acceptance of the new policy and procedures. There are no exceptions.

#### **Safety Protocols**

Parents must abide by the following guidelines

- 1. Staying home when appropriate
  - a. Do not bring student to program if they are not feeling well
    - i. Fever above 99.6°F, Coughing, Loss of taste or smell, Difficulty breathing, Any other COVID-19 related symptoms
  - b. If you or your student has:
    - i. Have tested positive or showed symptoms of COVID-19
      - 1. Student/staff who have tested positive with COVID-19 or is in quarantine with COVID-19 symptoms, should stay home for 5 days and test on the 5th day after last exposed.
        - a. EXCEPTION: If student is up to date with their COVID-19 vaccines (fully vaccinated and with a booster shot), proof of vaccination will be required. Student must be asymptomatic and provide test result for COVID-19 on day 5 after exposure to return to class
    - ii. Anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 will not be allowed to return until
      - 1. Negative test result is provided to MECA School Program Associate or;
      - 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test date. Student must be asymptomatic and/or symptoms are improving. Student must not have a fever, nausea, vomit or diarrhea and must be without medication for 24 hours before attending class.
- 2. Parents Drop-off and Pick-Up will be completed outside of the building.
  - a. Parents MUST remain in the car for drop off and pick up. Parents will NOT enter building, staff member will greet each car and screen child prior to parent leaving.
  - b. Should a parent have a legitimate need (reason must be pre-approved prior to the date entering) to enter the building, the parent must sign in with the receptionist first before proceeding into the building.
  - C. Recommend same person pick up and drop off student to limit confusions on pick up process.
- 3. All parents are REQUIRED to attend Zoom Orientation and/or in person orientation prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the program/starting the program. Date of Orientation TBA.
- 4. Breakfast & Lunch
  - a. Lunches are provided by the Parks and Recreation Services. If you are choosing to send student with a lunch, please provide a lunch that does not require assistance to open or that needs to be heated. Examples of 'easy to open' lunches are Lunchables and Sandwiches. NO VISITORS/PARENTS ARE ALLOWED DURING THEIR BREAKFAST/LUNCH TIME.
  - b. Children are encouraged to bring in their own water bottles. Refills stations will be available throughout the day

### MECA General Guidelines

- All staff and volunteers will be trained on appropriate cleaning and disinfecting hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. Students will wash/sanitize hands after each class
- 2. Class will have no more than 15 students, 1/2 counselor, and 1 teacher.
