## 2023 Summer Day Camp | Parent and Student Code of Conduct

MECA wants to provide its students with the highest quality of classical, contemporary, and multicultural performing and visual arts education. In order to do this, MECA students must observe program policies. For those students who are minors, parents must take responsibility for their children's artistic and academic growth by supporting these policies.

### Registration and Weekly fees

There is a **non-refundable** registration fee of \$30.00, \$45.00, or \$60.00 depending on when you register your child for the summer day camp. MECA's summer day camp cost is on a weekly fee basis, therefore, **it is due at the beginning of each week (Monday or Tuesday)**, unless other arrangements have been made when consulting with the registrar. The fees may be paid by check, money order, credit card (Master/Visa). Credit card payments are preferred and can be made by phone or set up on a recurring basis by completing an authorization form. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER CLASSES BEGIN.** Any past due fees, for any MECA program, must be paid prior to enrolling in the summer day camp.

Fees are on a sliding scale depending on combined family income and the number of people in the household. **Proof of income is required.** Families must meet with the registrar for further assistance. Fees are not prorated if student misses a day of the week.

The need for a disciplined environment requires the following from our students and parents. **Please read through and initial that you accept our guidelines.**

- Minors are not to loiter outside the building. \_\_\_\_\_
- Minors are not allowed to leave campus for any reason. Walking to nearby stores and restaurants is prohibited. \_\_\_\_\_
- Drugs, weapons, and abusive language are not permitted at MECA. \_\_\_\_\_
- ELECTRONICS, JEWELRY OR VALUABLE ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED. \_\_\_\_\_
- MECA is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or misplaced items. \_\_\_\_\_
- No backpacks and purses allowed. Lunch bags/lunchbox are permissible. \_\_\_\_\_
- **Students cannot be dropped off earlier than 8:30 a.m. and must be picked up by 5:30 p.m., if they are not a part of the early drop off.** \_\_\_\_\_
- **There will be an additional fee charged if student is dropped off earlier than 8:30 am. Extended day is NO LONGER AVAILABLE. All students must be picked by 5:30 pm. Additional fee of \$5 per every 5 minutes (minimum) will be billed and must be paid on that day.** \_\_\_\_\_
- Lunches and snacks are provided by the Houston Parks and Recreation Services, therefore we must abide but their regulations. No lunches or snacks may be taken out of the auditorium at any time. \_\_\_\_\_
- **Due to current health concerns, COVID-19, no unauthorized visitors or parents are allowed in the building at any time.** \_\_\_\_\_

- **Update for summer camp effective 3/21/23. In order to be able to complete a successful final production, students must be registered for a minimum of 3 weeks continuously. Therefore no new students will be able to start after week 6.** \_\_\_\_\_

### Disciplinary Action \_\_\_\_\_

Disregard of the above rules calls for disciplinary action. First the student is given a verbal warning. Second, a parent/teacher meeting is scheduled. Third, if the problem persists, the student will be dismissed from MECA without a refund.

MECA pledges to provide the highest standard in art disciplines. MECA pledges to provide a qualified teaching staff. MECA pledges to promote, support, and encourage the best from each student. ## MECA – 2023 Summer Sunburst Day Camp - COVID19 - Protocols

It is MECA's priority to provide a safe and healthy environment for all students. Due to the current COVID-19 (Coronavirus), we will be implementing additional guidelines that all students, parents, teaching staff and administrative must follow. At the end of this document all parents will be required to sign this document in acceptance of the new policy and procedures. There are no exceptions.

### Safety Protocols

Parents must abide by the following guidelines

1. Staying home when appropriate
  - a. Do not bring student to program if they are not feeling well
    - i. Fever above 99.6°F
    - ii. Coughing, Loss of taste or smell, Difficulty breathing, Any other COVID-19 related symptoms
  - b. If you or your student has:
    - i. Had close contact with a person with COVID-19
      1. Student/staff who have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or is in quarantine with COVID-19 symptoms, should stay home for 5 days and test on the 5th day after last exposed.
        - a. EXCEPTION: If student is up to date with their COVID-19 vaccines (fully vaccinated and with a booster shot), proof of vaccination will be required. Student must be asymptomatic and provide test result for COVID-19 on day 5 after exposure to return to class
    - ii. Have tested positive or showed symptoms of COVID-19
    - iii. Anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 will not be allowed to return until
      1. Negative test result is provided to MECA Out of School Director or;
      2. 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test date. Student must be asymptomatic and/or symptoms are improving. Student must not have a fever, nausea, vomit or diarrhea and must be without medication for 24 hours before attending class.
2. Parents Drop-off and Pick-Up will be completed outside of the building.
  - a. **Parents MUST remain in the car for drop off and pick up. Parents will NOT enter building, staff member will greet each car and screen child prior to parent leaving.**
  - b. Should a parent have a legitimate need (**reason must be pre-approved prior to the date entering**) to enter the building, the parent will be screened and must abide by the building regulation such as wearing masks and maintaining 6 feet social distance regulation.
  - c. Recommend same person pick up and drop off student to limit exposure
3. All parents are REQUIRED to attend Zoom Orientation and/or in person orientation prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the program/starting the program. Date of Orientation TBA.
4. Breakfast & Lunch
  - a. Lunches are provided by the Parks and Recreation Services. If you are choosing to send student with a lunch, please provide a lunch that does not require assistance to open or that needs to be heated. Examples of 'easy to open' lunches are Lunchables and Sandwiches. **NO VISITORS/PARENTS ARE ALLOWED DURING THEIR LUNCH TIME.**
  - b. Children are encouraged to bring in their own water bottles. Refills stations will be available throughout the day

### MECA General Guidelines

1. All staff and volunteers will be trained on appropriate cleaning and disinfecting hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. Students will wash/sanitize hands after each class
2. Class will have no more than 15 students, 1/2 counselor, and 1 teacher.
3. If camper or staff member is diagnosed with COVID-19:
  - MECA will advise all parents immediately by phone/email/in writing
    - i. If one case occurs:
      - MECA will begin disinfecting process overnight and close for a day
      - Contact Trace
    - ii. If more than 2 cases occur within a week:
      - Determine if we should close for the rest of the week or longer
