# Sunburst Summer Arts Camp

## Summer Camp K-9th

The Sunburst Summer Arts Program is an 8-week camp that implements a unique curriculum created by the MECA Arts Team with feedback and contributions from partnering agencies. The course blends arts education and academic techniques to address the learning loss that often occurs when students are out of school for the summer. The curriculum for this program places an added emphasis in the study of Numeracy, Literacy, and Social Emotional Learning (SEL). Additionally, the syllabus promotes awareness about the multiculturalism found in everyday life and the importance of celebrating it. This program is tuition based and is often supplemented by private donors, corporations, foundations, and state and federal funding channeled through groups like the Harris County Department of Education.

This year's Día de Muertos two-day celebration will offer children's art activities, an ofrendas/altar exhibition, artist and artisan vendors, delectable festival foods, and three captivating performance stages.



# ABOUT MECA

MECA is a community-based non-profit BIPOC organization committed to the healthy development of under-served & under represented families through arts and cultural programming, the promotion of academic excellence, support services, and community building. Founded in 1977 by Alice Valdez as the first citywide multicultural festival, its purpose was to honor the various cultural/ethnic groups living in the inner city through music, dance, cuisine, visual and folk art. Since incorporating in 1979, MECA has provided invaluable arts experiences for families to who might not otherwise have access.

Monumental milestones include being recognized as the 382nd Point of Light by President George H.W. Bush, transitioning from tenant to landlord of the former HISD Dow School, Mariachi MECA being designated as an NEA American Masterpieces Touring Artist for 2009, and most recently on bequest of Mayor Sylvester Turner in 2019 - assuming management of the former TBH Center in Houston's East End.
